But until Christ comes back we intend to occupy in the field of Jewish Missions both in Ukraine and worldwide and wish you to have the strength to conduct the ministries He has entrusted you with as well as to conduct your lives in a God pleasing manner.

In the month of November I preached in seven churches in Dnepropetrovsk and Vinnitsa region where I travelled with my son Nikita as we do every year around this time for the past ten years. **God has blessed with four souls saved and many rededications.** On Saturday morning I preached at the pastors' conference to about 400 men and women as one of the main speakers. I thank the Lord for providing me with these speaking opportunities year after year and especially for my son Nikita being able to now travel with me. My prayer is that one day he will take me along to some of his meetings as he serves the Lord.

Upon my return from our furlough in USA at the end of September I have picked up and conducted the English Club that is held at Eastern Gate Baptist church that is designed to attract students willing to learn English language with hopes to eventually see them saved and plugged into EGBC. We have had a steady attendance of up to 20 people with half of that number being new comers every other meeting. Pastor Dmitry picks up this responsibility on Saturday evenings when I am not in town.

I have known this Jewish man Gena Kaminer for about two years now - a former high city official who had been re-elected recently and reassigned to a different office. We struck a pretty good relationship and last month he has introduced me to his wife and daughter who was about to get married. They know of my Christian stand and have been witnessed to on different occasions. Gena told me he would have invited me to his daughter's wedding, which was conducted in a strict but festive Jewish way, but did not want my confrontations with some of his religious Hassidic friends, so I did not get invited, however requested to possibly meet those friends individually (and have one-on-one confrontations!) Please, pray for this lost Jewish family and open doors for me to be a witness to them.

The Family is doing just fine. All the kids are in school and attend many after-school activities (Dasha takes singing, English and journalist classes; Nikita goes to the gym; Sophie and Evan take English and other misc. classes). Everyone is healthy, praise the Lord. Olga and I are great and in love. It is relatively safe and calm where we live.

My Family and I, as we reflect upon the past year, thank the Lord for blessing us with such friends and supporters that we have in you. We had a busy but wonderful time in the US and want to once again thank you for your generosity and kindness. Let us continue to stay together in God's work of Jewish Missions in the upcoming year both in Ukraine and worldwide! Do continue to pray for us, please, and let the Lord recompense you for all the sacrificial support you send our way.
