We are on the go to New York City! God's timing has finally arrived. We have secured an apartment in Brooklyn, NY, that is close to the church we will be serving in. As well, it is in good, safe neighborhood. My prayer this past week as I was looking at apartments was, 'God, I know you have a place prepared for us here somewhere. Please reveal it to me in a way that I know it is what you have provided.' Here are some ways God answered that prayer. To let us know that it was His timing, as I was driving from West Virginia to Brooklyn, He laid it on someone's heart to give us what we had projected as 2 month's rent (\$3,200). To show us He had provided the place for us, out of all the places I had scheduled to look at that weekend, the one He gave us wasn't even on the market. It came as word of mouth through a real estate agent's dentist office. And what made the situation even more unique is that the landlord (the dentist whose office is below the apartment) didn't require any papers to sign, just a handshake. I'm so thankful for how our God works.

Our move-in date is November 4th, a month to the date I am writing this letter. Pastor Walker of Bay Ridge Baptist Church in Brooklyn is pleased that we will be joining his church to work and to learn as we get established in this new environment. One of his church members called me to thank me for coming. He said, 'The harvest is bustin' at the seams,' and he's right. It had been 3 years since I had been to New York, and I am again reminded that it is not the America that many of us are familiar with. It is a place destitute of the Truth and where the churches are made up of many young Christians who are hungry for the Word. I have already talked to some pastors about how we can get involved in discipleship, soul-winning training, planting more churches, and being help to the churches in New York City.

Many thanks and blessings to you who have continued to give during the beginnings of this ministry. I look forward to see how God will use us in as a unique a way that He brought us here.
