Dear Praying Friends:

“There is nothing impossible with God” Luke 2. I would like to express my gratitude for your prayers concerning our ministry in Cuba, and for our family. The Lord answered your prayers opening doors for the preaching of the Gospel, and for protection over my family while I was not at home.

During these past couple of months I have started, by faith, to coordinate some of the evangelistic efforts I would like to develop in different towns and cities. We are putting a lot of effort on the discipleship programs for those people that we lead to the Lord. That is one of the priorities before our special Outreach that the pastor shows me a strategy on how to discipleship the fruits that will come after the preaching of the Gospel. The Gospel is the power of God, and it is bringing salvation and conviction of sin toward our Cuban people!

LITTLE TOWN AND A GREAT COMMISION

I held the first “End Time Outreach” Evangelistic Event with only national preachers and missionaries, in a very small town called “Ceiba Mocha” in the province of Matanzas. It was far from my house. There is no phone service at all. This time I used Pastor Carlos Miguel as the guest speaker for Friday night, and I was the guest speaker for Saturday and Sunday night.

I took eight national missionaries with me and **by the grace of the Lord we were able see 62 precious souls come to Christ.** I started my letter with such a statement because the Lord opened doors for me to be able to do things that had never been done before



in our communist country. I could not believe we were going to get permission from the local authorities to do it. We were able to put our evangelistic posters on the main square, on two stores, the hospital and the houses of the church members! We were also able to spread our flyers at a kid’s school and the children ripped the flyers from our hands! It was like we were giving them candy! We even used 60 chairs from that very school to populate the church for the visitors to come! What a time of blessing! These eight missionaries worked with me during 5 days of street evangelism. We spread the flyers house by house in a town of eight thousand people and only 29 local church members. We started on Thursday morning and by Friday night we already had gone to all the houses in town. Then we started to go to the people on the streets, or to closer communities. Each time the opportunity showed up, we preached the Gospel and there were more professions of faith during our work on the streets than the ones we had in our services, in fact 24 out of the 62 were during our services and 38 were won by the street efforts.

I was so excited to see what the Lord was doing and to hear from the pastor and the other brothers and sisters testimonies of the mighty hand of God. This pastor has been there for about 1 year now and he told me his church was known in town as the **“Dead church”**. We believe in a living God and we have to lift His name high and we did it this week! The town was shocked about what was going on during this week. We were hindered by the weather because it rained all week and when it rains people usually do not like to go out at night. Two days I finished my street work completely wet because of the rain and two of our missionaries were even chased by a bull. All of it was worth when **I was blessed to lead the town’s barber, teachers, and communist people to conviction of sin and salvation thru Jesus Christ our Lord.** In fact I stayed in the house of a lady member of the church, but her husband had communist beliefs and never went to church. He came with me to the services every night, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, We had a tremendous talk on Saturday night after the service until 1 am. He did not know what to say, I told him I wanted him to consider everything we talked about and that I did not want to leave the town without an answer. **By the Glory of God when I made the invitation on Sunday night, he was the second person that came forward!** Tears started to fall from my eyes and from his wife too. No Government or education can give the peace only Jesus can give! GLORY TO GOD! Every day I surrender all to Him!

Do you remember the town of Colon where we celebrated one of our events no more than 2 months ago? I got a call from pastor Esdras Carvajal and he said they have **opened 4 new house churches** in this short of a time! If the pastor and the church members continue the discipleship, the fruit that we left behind will transform this town with the power of the Gospel.

FAMILY UPDATE

My family rejoices to be able to serve the Lord. My wife now has a big belly and although she had some struggling carrying the house responsibilities and taking care of Naomi in my travelling, we are all fine now and together. She has her cesarean scheduled for the end of June.

Please pray that the Lord will anoint me with his blessing and power to speak the Word of God with boldness. Pray for my wife and for the new baby girl to come!

THE NEXT STEP

I can’t wait to do the next Outreach! I have two places that want me to come and conduct special meetings. One of them is “Santa Maria del Rosario” a town of 5 thousand people and a church of 37, and the other is “Catalina de Güines” a town of 8 thousand people and a church of 50 members. I’m planning the next Outreach for June 7-9. Pray that many will be saved there. Thank you for helping me financially to do these great meetings.
